

A SUMMARY OF CSR ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN DURING FINANCIAL YEAR 2022-23

During the financial year 2022-23, the Company has spent INR 40 lakhs towards Corporate Social Responsibility on the CSR projects/programs and the Company is in compliance with the statutory requirements in this regard. The Company has made a total contribution of INR 40 lakhs to the Olympic Gold Quest, Foundation for Promotion of Sports and Games (“OGQ”) during the Financial Year 2022-23. The Company had focused on undertaking a CSR activity to help Indian athletes to win Olympic Gold medals. OGQ also holds the 8OG & 12A Certificate. OGQ is a not-for-profit organization co-founded by Indian sports legends Geet Sethi and Prakash Padukone with a mission to help Indian athletes win Olympic and Paralympic Gold medals. In the last 3 Olympics at London 2012, Rio 2016 and Tokyo 2020, the training of 9 of the 15 medal winners for India was supported by OGQ.

OGQ has a vision to scout for potential medal talent, to help identify areas of support, to work with all stakeholders to aid deserving talent. At the Tokyo Olympics 2020, 4 of the 7 medal winners for India were supported by OGQ, viz., Mirabai Chanu, Ravi Kumar, PV Sindhu and Lovlina Borgohain. OGQ also supports athletes with physical disabilities, and at the Tokyo Paralympics, 10 of the 19 medal winners for India were supported by OGQ including Krishna Nagar who won the Gold medal in Para Badminton.
